

Clements International's 2011 Expat Youth Scholarship

About the EYS

Now in its third year, Clements International's Expat Youth Scholarship is a unique contest exclusively for expat students who spend their childhoods moving between different countries and cultures.

This year's theme asks participants to **create a video explaining their favorite thing about their host country and its culture.**

Entry Requirements

Create a 2-3 minute video explaining your favorite thing about your host country and its culture. If you have lived abroad in more than one country, please only select one. Entries must be in English.

The deadline is Friday, May 13, 2011 at 11:59 p.m. EST (U.S.).

Eligibility

- Students ages 12-18 of any nationality who have resided in a foreign country for at least two consecutive years are eligible to apply.
- You must have lived outside your home country (country of passport). If you have more than one passport, your home country is the country where you obtained your first passport.

Awards

Clements is awarding a total of \$10,000 in scholarships to six students in the following categories:

Category One (Ages 12 -15)
